LymeVax® Vaccine for Dogs

Lyme Disease is caused by transmission of bacteria that is spread by ticks. Symptoms of Lyme Disease are non-specific and can mimic many other conditions. Some symptoms include the following:

- **Fever**
- **Lethargy**
- **Arthritis**
- **Poor appetite**
- **Lameness or joint pain**

Any dog exposed to infected ticks can develop Lyme Disease. This is especially true for dogs that walk or play in wooded areas and tall grasses. Even “indoor” dogs can be exposed to Lyme Disease in backyards, outdoor walks, camping trips and outings.

Our hospital strongly recommends that you vaccinate your dog against Lyme Disease. Lyme vaccination is part of our routine protocol and a vaccine called LymeVax® is available. It is administered as two doses given 2-3 weeks apart followed by a yearly booster.
